This class is intended for people who are comfortable with what is discussed in Basic Computer Skills and Beginning Windows 10. Most of the class is spent discussing Settings that customize System, attached devices, Internet, Display, installed applications, Accounts, Clock, Accessibility, Privacy and Security. The Control Panel has been improved upon to make customizing your computer easier. There are now 14 sections within the Windows Settings, but we will not be discussing the Phone, Gaming or Cortana settings.
